A fall harvest feast wine dinner at Varanese, 2106 Frankfort Ave., on Nov. 17 at 6:30 p.m. will feature autumn's bounty, including wild game and venison.

"For me it's kind of kicking off the season," says chef/owner John Varanese.

Also on the six-course menu is Turducken, a combination of turkey, duck and chicken. "It's really delicious because the flavors of all the meats meld together," Varanese said. "The fat in the duck really gets a chance to render off. It keeps its moisture...this is the one turkey you won't dry out."

The dinner costs \$65 per person plus tax and gratuity.
